Authentic High Country Station Experience.

2 -3 days

There was a time when new acquaintances sat down at the kitchen table and really got to know one another. They talked about family and friends, about beliefs and values, about good times and bad. Hard work, standing on your own feet, and accepting responsibility were expected from an early age. That kind of thing still exists at Dunstan Downs, a high-country sheep station in the Lindis Pass. Tim and Geva Innes (and son Charlie) are the real deal. Straight talk is what you get. Four generations of Inneses have farmed at the Dunstan. Love of the land and the independent life-style are what they bring to the table.

Why not take a post-conference holiday with the Innes family? Take a walk with Geva and learn about the flora of the pastureland. View the rich variety of birdlife. Hike into the high-country and take in the sweeping vistas. Challenge yourself to a 15 km trek for an overnight (or longer) stay at the remote Fat Man's Lodge Hut. You can carry your own gear or Tim can deliver your supplies to the hut. Fish the picturesque Ahuriri river or one of the McKenzie Country lakes. Go rabbit shooting in the evenings with Charlie. Or hunt for larger game, with Himalayan tahr and deer on offer. We can even organize a glider flight (or lesson) in Omarama so you can experience the high country from the air.

In-house rooms for three couples and spotless, well-appointed backpackers accommodations for up to 17 are available.

Cost: Prices vary according to your individually planned package, but start at \$175 per day per person (backpackers accommodations) or \$225 per day per person (private in-house room), including meals, and station activities. Self-catered options can be arranged at a lower price. Transportation by four-wheel drive vehicle to the high-country walks or the hut, glider rides, or private guides for fishing or tramping will cost extra. We can discuss cost options when planning your trip to the high country.
